2nd - Zabush Cully

Moderately angulation, balanced, lovely wiry coat texture, good ears, would like a darker eye especially on this dark coat colour. A very friendly chap but was giving his handler a hard time by sitting and laying down, handler worked patiently to get him back up using his favourite treats, well done!

Open Dog

Moderately angulated front and rear yet balanced, nice outline and pleasing overall shape, nice head and ears, good bone, good texture to the coat. Good sized boy and extremely sound on the move.

Champion Dog

1st - Ch Mukonry Dylon of Cuaine

Has great presence when entering the ring, obviously loves to move and show. Balanced throughout, nice curves especially on the outline. Lovely ears. I did like this Dog and he has a lot going for him, but would have liked more bone and a more masculine appearance especially the head.

2nd - Ch Doscartha Made In Finland of Zabush (Imp Fin)

A dog of great size and bone. Very hairy. Good shoulder and forechest. Seems to be going over on the pasterns slightly, good feet. Lacks rear angulation, so for me lacked the balance of the first dog. Lovely head and expression, however the front incisors totally worn down. Good ears. You could see this was a male. On the move he looks powerful but the hocks flip out, looks flashy but not correct.

Graduate Bitch

1st - Duross Ghita

Beautiful type, well angulated throughout, loved her overall outline and shape, harsh coat. Strong, balanced yet feminine head, lovely expression with pitch black eyes. Ears worked beautifully. A little wide in front and paddles slightly when moving towards me. But on the side gait she moves beautifully balanced. Excellent bone. Good feet, round and well arched toes.

2nd - Zabush Piper

A little fine in bone, good angles front and rear, good balance, moves well, pretty head, would like a darker eye, long neck, would like better feet. Softer coat than 1st place.

SA Bred Bitch

1st - Swordstone Mystic

Love the head and expression on this girl, long neck. Good ears. Nice outline and overall shape. Good bone and size.

2nd - Ch Glengarrif Tarryn JM

Would like more bone, too long in loin for me, croup quite steep and can stand a little high in the rear at times. Moderately angulated in the rear.
